### Overview of Major Tax Policy Legislation

- Corporate and Individual Income Tax
  - Consolidated 7 brackets to flat rate for Corp and Individual.
  - Lowered rates from 7.4% to a flat 5.8%.
  - 3 separate rebate checks.
  - Moving slowly towards 5.0%.
- \$410 million of annual funding directly from the state's sales tax to the public-school income.
- SALT Deduction for Business, Single Sales Factor Market Based Sourcing.

#### Overview of Major Tax Policy Legislation

- Property Tax Relief over the last several years;
  - Transparency Legislation.
  - Cap Growth at 8%.
  - Reduction through state funding local school districts & direct relief for owner-occupied properties.
    - Lowered Property taxes by 23% on average for owner occupied.
    - Lowered all other property taxes by approximately 5% on average.
  - 2024 Legislative Session 10-year bond for schools \$1.0B in Property tax relief through state funding.




